


# Disc Golf Genève is presenting you:





### PDGA C-Tier Swiss Championships 2021

### **Tournament officials:**

### **Divisions:**

MPO, FPO, MJ18, MP40, FP40, MP50, MP60 in accordance to the SDA standards.

### Format:

3 rounds of 15 holes, golf start (see Schedule). Final 9 for top 4 (top 8 in MPO and MP40).



The tournament center is located at the Belvedere room (on top of the metallic stairs by hole 15). Players will have to leave their bag at the entrance. When entering the room, players must disinfect their hand. A mask must be worn until the player is seated. The maximum capacity of the room is 65 people.

You can also find a first-aid kit there.

### Meals and accomodation:

A salad buffet will be available for the players (10 CHF by meal) at the Belvedere room. It will also be possible to eat your own lunch at the tournament center.

For the players that have booked the dormitory, we invite you to take a sleeping bag and a pillow with you.

### **Safety and spotters:**

We do not plan to have spotters. The course being located in a public park, we kindly ask the players to take extreme care before they throw and to follow the indications on the tee-signs for everyone's safety.

### **Transportation and parking**

To access les Evaux, we highly recommand the players to use public transportation (tramway 14, bus J et K, stop "Onex – Salle communale"; bus 21 et 43, stop "Vallet"; bus 2 et 19, stop "Onex – Cité" + 10-15 walk), soft mobility or car-sharing.

Players taking part of the Swiss Championships can use the P2 parking in les Evaux located at the corner of the chmin François-Chavaz. The parking can be used free of charge from Friday at 9AM to sunday evening without any time limits. It is forbidden to bivouac there, but the vehicles can stay there for the night.

### **Doubles:**

1 round of 15 holes, Modified Alternate Shot.

Mixed & Open

Entry-fee: 10 CHF per pair. Please bring the exact

amount. Golf start.

100% Payout for Top 3 (Open) and Winners (Mixed)

Modified alternate shot: Player 1 drives on odd holes, player 2 drives on even holes. Subsequent shots on a hole are taken alternatively.





### Rules:

PDGA (2019 Rulebook) et SDV

The 2-meter rule is not in effect.

OB zones are delimited by existing objects (paths, fences, walls, etc.). The limit for the running track and the grass football field is the first white line (out). The limit for the synthetic (turf) field is the concrete (out).

No sound signals will be emitted for the tee-time. Players must check the time by themselves. Repeated sound signals will alert you in case of a play interruption due to dangerous playing conditions. Come back immediately to the tournament center where new instructions will be given for the restart of play.

« Sudden death » are played to break the ties for 1st place on holes 15 and 1 until the tie is broken.

We invite you to respect the 30-seconds rule (Excessive time) and the 3-minutes rule (Lost disc).

In case of a doubt, play provisional shots, take note of both scores and ask the officials for confirmation. **Dress Code:** Thank you for respecting it.

### **Scoring:**

Scoring will be done via DG Metrix. One player per group is responsible to entre the scores. Each player must verify their own scorecards at the end of the round. It is also possible to check your scorecard with the TD at the end of the round.

### **Players meeting:**

No Players Meeting. Questions on the Caddy Book must be sent in advance on DG Metrix.

### CTP and Hole-In-One:

This year, no CTP prize is planned. 5 CHF for the Ace-Pool, 255 CHF currently

### Prizes:

Non-Am players receive Prize Money in accordance to the PDGA C-Tier standards.

The Hole-In-One pot is split between all the players.

Min. 60% for the first Hole-In-One.





### Price of the services:

The entry-fee must be paid prior to the tournament. Your registration will be confirmed as we receive your payment.

Entry-fee: 55 CHF (25 CHF for Juniors). Included the player's package (disc, snack and drink).

### Spirit of the game:

Disc golf is typically played without the supervision of a referee or umpire.

The game relies on the player to show sportsmanship, integrity, consideration for other players, and to abide by the Rules of Play. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be.

Make the call. Accept the call. It's not personal; it's the rules. That is the spirit of the game of disc golf.

### **Smoking policy:**


At the Swiss Championship the SDA tobacco regulation will be applied. This concerns players from the two minute warning until the handing out of the score cards. The ban concerns smoking products and e-cigarettes / vaporizers.

A visible violation of the tobacco regulation will be punished as an etiquette violation. The person involved will be asked to put the product away until after the round. A further violation will be penalized with one penalty point according to PDGA Rule 812.C. Repeated violations may be penalized by disqualification according to PDGA Tournament Manual 3.03.





Course Map








# Hole n°1



- Island hole
- If the drive is OB, go to the DZ with one stroke penalty
- From the DZ, normal OB rules apply.

# Hole n°2




- OB path and beyond (right) → Retee if path not crossed
- OB football fields (left)
- Careful with hole n°10





# Hole n°3 Swiss Championships

- OB running track (right)
- OB synthetic football field (left)
- Mandatory spotter on the path leading to the track.



- The teeing area (mat) is not OB.
- If the drive is OB, go to the DZ with one stroke penalty.
- From the DZ, normal OB rules apply.





# Hole n°5



- OB path/line and beyond (left)
- Mandatory on the marked tree (arrow)
- Watch out for hole n°6 !!!

# Hole n°6 (F1)



- OB path and beyond (long)
- Watch out for hole n°5 !!!





# Hole n°7 (F2)



Watch out for the crossing path (walkers and bikes) !!!

# Hole n°8



- Retee if Mando missed
- OB path and beyond (left))
- Watch out for hole n°4 !!!






# Hole n°9 (F3)



- OB fence and beyond (left)
- OB running track (long)
- Watch out for hole n°4 (tee) !!!

# Hole n°10 (F4)



- OB pond (left)
- OB path (right)
- Watch our for hole n°2 (fairway) !!!





# Hole n°11 (F5)




- OB fenced areas
- OB path left and long
- Mandatory on the marked tree (arrow)
- If missed Mando, go to the DZ with one penalty stroke
















# Hole n°15 (F9)



- OB line and beyond (right, left and long)
- If the drive is OB, go to the DZ with one penalty stroke.
- From the DZ, normal OB rules apply.
